

### Dear Friend,

#### "For the Word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12).

"You ... you mean this Book has a list of ancestors? The actual names of the world's first people?"



'Yes, you're looking at the genealogy of Jesus Christ,' Jo said to Ama. 'It goes back to the early people on earth. But those are just names.'

'You mean this Book is true? These are the actual names of the people?'

For the Balangao people, having the actual names of the people was proof that the Bible was really a true story, a record, and not just make-believe" ("Forever **Changed by the Book**," page 10, copyright by Bible Visuals International).

It was by reading Matthew's genealogy, which most of us just skip over or skim, Canao aka Ama realized the stories Jo Shelter was telling the Balangao people in the Philippians were true. This opened the door for Jo to share the Gospel and led to a whole people group being **changed by the Book**. During the Summer of 2021 we had the privilege of sharing this story with children challenging them to think about whether they have been **changed by the Book**.

Sad to say according to Statista in May of 2021, 29% of Americans 18 years and older have never read the Book and another 29% have only read it a few times a year. Only 11% read it daily with another 14% who read it several times a week. Those who read it once a week (9%) do not differ much from those who read it once a month (8%). Although the Bible is easily accessible, Americans are not reading it and, therefore, are not changed by the Book.

Are you concerned for the state of our country? We are, which is why we are committed to sharing the Gospel with the children and training others how to do the same. Our desire is for this next generation to be forever **changed by the Book** like the Balangao people for only the Bible has the power to change hearts and lives. *"For the Word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."* (Hebrews 4:12). Each of us has been changed by the Book and desire for the next generation to be changed as well. Will you help us?




## <u>Ministry Finances</u>


# March Good News Club



# **Summer Missionary Training School**
